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## Home School Agreement - September 2021

As a Federation of schools we are committed to working in partnership with pupils, parents, staff and Governors in providing the best possible education for your child. This document sets out aims and beliefs, and the expectations and responsibilities that we have of each other

### We, the School will:

- do everything we reasonably can to keep your child safe
- encourage your child to do his/her best at all times and celebrate his/her achievements
- encourage your child to take care of their surroundings and others around them
- inform you of your child's progress relating to any targets set
- provide a range of activities that meet his/her needs

### You, the Parent or Carer will:

- ensure that your child arrives at school on time and ready to learn having made arrangements for a safe journey home at the end of the school day (or at the end of an after-school club)
- make sure that your child attends regularly, phoning the school on the first day of absence or sending a note with an attending sibling
- avoid taking holidays during term time
- attend Parents' Evenings to discuss your child's progress
- ensure that any homework is completed appropriately
- make good use of the home/school reading system to encourage lifelong reading habits
- make sure that your child wears full school uniform
- work with the school to ensure that your child behaves well
- not use any form of social media to comment negatively about the school but to contact the school directly if you have an issue

- wear my full school uniform
- take good care of equipment and the building
- always ask for help with my work when I need it
